Professor Emeritus, University of Tsukuba, Japan

1963 – Attained PhD from Kyoto University, Japan. The Graduate School of Agriculture.
Agriculture Chemistry

1963 – Researcher, Oregon Health and Science University.

1976 – Associate Professor, School of Medicine, Vanderbilt University.

1978 – Professor, University of Tsukuba. He devoted his research to study the gene
structure and function.

1983 – He succeeded in decoding the enzyme “Renin,” which is involved in high blood
pressure. Hi achievement commended considerable attention in the world of
medical science.

1996 – He received the Japan Academy Prize.
